Prologue

Audience :: Though containing a profound Jewish quality, the universal tone would imply a wider audience than simply the diaspora. (Jewish Readers as well as the Gentile World) Intent :: to foster a sense of progress of belief for both Jewish and Gentile readers providing adequate information for their belief to grow. • John Does not Contain: Parables, Account of the Birth, Baptism, Transfiguration, Temptation, Agony in the Garden, or Ascension of Jesus, Record of Demonic Contact, Institution of the Lords Supper, or a List of the Twelve Disciples

• His Focus: Jesus' ministry in Jerusalem, the Jewish Feasts, Jesus' private conversations with individuals, the preparation of the Disciples
